

Qualification:

Congratulations! Your team has qualified for the knockout stages of this year's event!

Player Age Eligibility:

We know there was some confusion regarding age eligibility at the start of the season which we apologise for. To confirm for the knockout stage of this event, we are accepting both interpretations of the rule, meaning all players that competed in the group stage are also eligible for the knockout stage. To confirm this means we are accepting the following interpretations:

8U: 2013 or later AND 2014 or later
9U: 2012 or 2013 AND 2013 or 2014
10U: 2011 or 2012 AND 2012 or 2013
11U: 2010 or 2011 AND 2011 or 2012
12U: 2009 or 2010 AND 2010 or 2011
14U: 2007 - 2010 AND 2008 – 2011
16U: 2005 - 2010 AND 2006 – 2011
18U: 2003 – 2010 AND 2004 – 2011

Round Dates:

The dates you see online are what we call 'round dates' meaning the match must be played before or on that date. In order to stop the draw from being delayed, we need all teams to stick to these timescales. It is the home team's responsibility to offer dates and times to the opposition. We would like 3 dates to be offered, of which one will be selected by the opposition.

Match Days:

Matches can be played on either Saturdays or Sundays, or another day mutually agreed by captains. Time is tight for all clubs this season so we ask that all clubs, captains, parents and players please be as flexible as possible.

Home/Away:

For the first match in the draw the home team is the team placed above their opposition on the draw sheet. After the first round, teams will be told if they are home or away.

Results:
