## Surrey Mixed Team Knockouts

Winter 2023/24

---

### Player Eligibility:

To ensure you do not field **INELIGIBLE** players please read the following:

- Tier 1 - The event is **ONLY** open to players playing in divisions 1-6 **THIS** Wilson Surrey Leagues winter season (2023/24)
- Tier 2 - The event is **ONLY** open to players playing in divisions 7 and below **THIS** Wilson Surrey Leagues winter season (2023/24)

### NOTE:

- Players who finished first and second in division 7 and first in division 8 at the end of 22/23 season must compete in Tier 1.
- Players who finished fifth and sixth in division 6 and sixth in division 5 at the end of 22/23 season must compete in Tier 2.
- If a player is not competing in the Wilson Surrey Leagues, Surrey Tennis will use other factors.

### Competition Structure:

- Matches are to be played on weekends unless captains agree otherwise.
- The event will begin in November and the finals day will take place in March 2024.
- Once entries close and draws have been made, team captains will be made aware of their opponent. You will also be told if you are playing at home or away at the oppositions club.
- Teams will have a date by which the match must be played. Rubber results to be submitted on-line within 48 hours of the match being completed and the organiser informed.
- Once the rubber results have been entered by the team captain and the league coordinator informed, teams will be told who has home advantage.
- For the first time, we have created a Consolation draw eligible to any team which loses their first match. The Consolation Finals will be played in one of the team's home club.

### Team Composition:

Team of 4 players per match (2 women and 2 men)

### Match Structure:

The Mixed Team Knockout will use a 'medley' format:

- Men's Doubles vs. Men's Doubles
- Women's Doubles vs Women's Doubles  
then...
- Mixed Doubles 1 vs Mixed Doubles 1
- Mixed Doubles 2 vs Mixed Doubles 2

### Scoring:

The scoring will be 2 Tie-Break sets followed at a set all by a Champions Tie-Break (to 10 points 2 clear).

Each match shall be decided on the combined results:

- a. If rubbers are tied, the number of sets won will decide.
- b. If sets are tied, the number of games won will decide.
- c. If games are tied, the combined result of the first two rubbers will decide first rubbers, then sets, then games.
- d. If a tie still prevails, then the result of the leading rubber, i.e. 1st mixed pair v 1st mixed pair, will decide the match.

### Finals Day:

- The Finals Day will take place on Sunday, 24th March 2024 at Westside Lawn Tennis Club, Wimbledon, SW19 4RF.

### Price:

The price per team entry is £25.
